


Class Practical

 \succ TASK-1: allocate 30 points according to their personal view on relevancy of the 3 views for AW



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




Did students' opinion change?

Before vs After: allocation of 30 points for 3 views (paired t-test)



Did students' opinion change?

Before vs After: 0-100 importance scores for areas 1-7



Conclusions

- Practical introduced AW as a <u>societal concept</u> with 3 main <u>views</u> (*Health Feelings Nature*)
- Practical illustrated how AW <u>assessment schemes</u> and <u>statements</u> depend on how AW is defined
- Practical made vet students <u>reconsider</u> their Health-centrered view (in favour of Feelings)
- > Only immediate (<u>short-term</u>) effect tested *Lasting effect?*?
